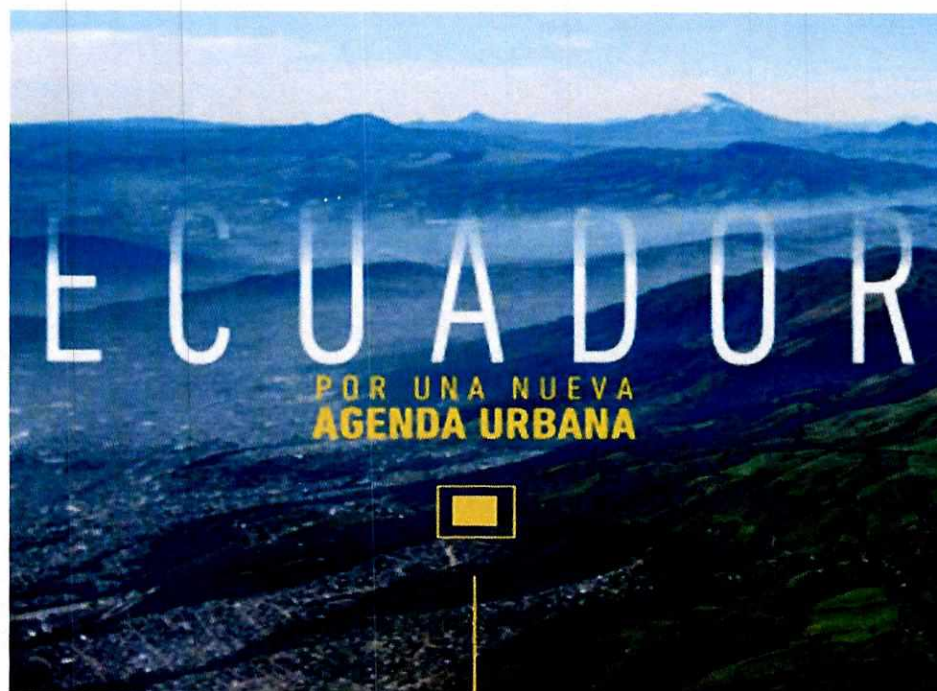

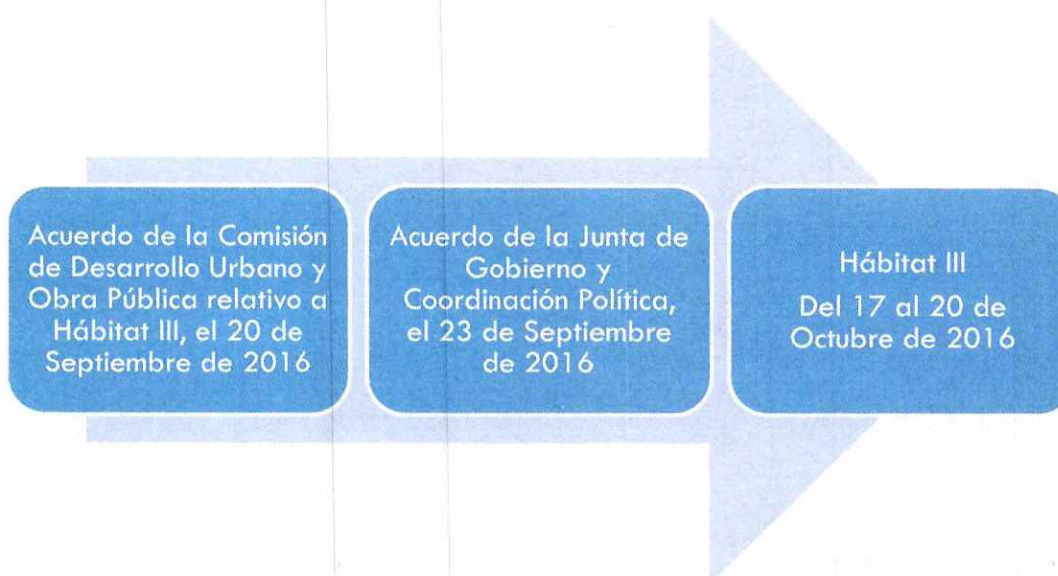

Jesús Oviedo Herrera.

# INFORME

## TERCERA CONFERENCIA DE LAS NACIONES UNIDAS SOBRE LA VIVIENDA Y EL DESARROLLO URBANO SOSTENIBLE.

### Proceso de participación de la Comisión de Desarrollo Urbano y Obra Pública.

A continuación se detalla el proceso parlamentario por el cual fue aprobada la participación del Diputado J. Jesús Oviedo Herrera en la Tercera Conferencia de las Naciones Unidas sobre la Vivienda y el Desarrollo Urbano Sostenible “Hábitat III”.



En primer lugar la Comisión de Desarrollo Urbano y Obra Pública en sesión del 20 de septiembre del año en curso abordó el Punto VI del Orden del Día relativo a información sobre VIVE HABITAT III, la Conferencia de las Naciones Unidas sobre Vivienda y Desarrollo Urbano Sostenible y, acordó por unanimidad de votos que el Presidente de la Comisión asistiera al evento y compartiera a los integrantes de la misma la información que le fuera proporcionada en dicho evento, lo anterior en virtud de la importancia del evento y la relación que guarda con los trabajos legislativos concernientes a la comisión.

Posteriormente el 23 de septiembre, tuvo verificativo la sesión ordinaria de la Junta de Gobierno y Coordinación Política donde se revisó la solicitud de anuencia para que el Diputado J. Jesús Oviedo Herrera acudiera en representación de la Comisión de Desarrollo Urbano y Obra Pública del Congreso del Estado de Guanajuato a la conferencia Hábitat III; Acordándose por unanimidad de votos autorizar la solicitud.

# ONU HABITAT

## POR UN MEJOR FUTURO URBANO

La Asamblea General de las Naciones Unidas decidió convocar la Conferencia Hábitat III con la finalidad de revitalizar el compromiso mundial hacia una urbanización sostenible y centrarse en la implementación de una Nueva Agenda Urbana basándose en las Agendas Hábitat, adoptadas en las anteriores conferencias de Vancouver 1976 Hábitat I y Estambul 1996 Hábitat II.

### GLOBAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORKS

Growing recognition of urbanization reflected in global frameworks for sustainable global development



La Conferencia Hábitat III tiene como misión la adopción de una Nueva Agenda Urbana, que es un documento orientado a la acción que establecerá los estándares globales del desarrollo urbano sostenible, replanteando la forma en que construimos, gestionamos y vivimos en las ciudades, a través de unos compromisos compartidos con los actores urbanos más relevantes y con todos los niveles de gobierno, sociedad civil y sector privado.

La Nueva Agenda Urbana fue acordada el pasado 10 de septiembre, culminando dos años de un proceso preparatorio incluyente y participativo de negociaciones y debates a nivel mundial. La Nueva Agenda Urbana es una guía para los Estados Miembros y las partes interesadas sobre los temas urbanos.

Tiene como base tres principios:

## PRINCIPIOS



- ☐ No dejar a nadie atrás.
- ☐ Economías urbanas sostenibles e inclusivas.
- ☐ Sostenibilidad ambiental

Además, la Nueva Agenda Urbana promueve conceptos y lineamientos fundamentales para que las ciudades sean más inclusivas, seguras, resilientes y sostenibles. Se promueve, entre otros, la densificación urbana, en lugar de la extensión del perímetro de las ciudades; el uso mixto del suelo, en lugar de la zonificación; la preservación de los paisajes y recursos naturales y los espacios públicos para todos.

## DESARROLLO HÁBITAT III

La Conferencia Hábitat III estuvo compuesta por ocho reuniones plenarias, incluidas la sesión de apertura y clausura, seis sesiones de mesas redondas de alto nivel y una amplia gama de eventos incluyendo sesiones especiales, diálogos, mesas redondas, eventos en línea y de capacitación, actividades culturales, académicas periodísticas, entre otras.

Además, se incluyeron espacios como Pabellones de información general y cultural de las Naciones Unidas, Quito y Ecuador.

ONU-Hábitat ha desarrollado una posición única de apoyo al desarrollo sostenible y a la planificación y construcción de un mejor futuro urbano para las nuevas generaciones. El proceso clave se apoya en el desarrollo económico y social, además de la reducción de la pobreza y la desigualdad.

Las prioridades de ONU-Hábitat se concentran en siete áreas:

1. Legislación urbana, suelo y gobernanza,
2. Planificación urbana y diseño,
3. Economía urbana,
4. Servicios básicos urbanos,
5. Vivienda,
6. Reducción de riesgos y rehabilitación, y
7. Investigación urbana y desarrollo de capacidades.

Con la adopción de estas prioridades los líderes del mundo han adoptado la Nueva Agenda Urbana, que establece un nuevo estándar mundial para el desarrollo urbano sostenible, y ayudará a repensar la forma de planificar, gestionar y vivir en las ciudades.



En la Nueva Agenda Urbana, los líderes a nivel mundial se han comprometido a:

- **Proporcionar servicios básicos para todos los ciudadanos**

Estos servicios incluyen: acceso a la vivienda, agua potable y saneamiento, alimentos nutritivos, atención de la salud y planificación familiar, educación, cultura y acceso a las tecnologías de comunicación.

- **Garantizar que todos los ciudadanos tengan acceso a la igualdad de oportunidades y libre de discriminación**

Toda persona tiene derecho a los beneficios que sus ciudades ofrecen. La Nueva Agenda Urbana pide a las autoridades de la ciudad tener en cuenta las necesidades de las mujeres, las personas con discapacidad, los grupos marginados, los ancianos, las poblaciones indígenas, entre otros grupos.

- **Promover medidas en apoyo de ciudades más limpias**

La lucha contra la contaminación del aire en las ciudades es buena para la salud de las personas y para el planeta. En la Agenda, los líderes se han comprometido a incrementar el uso de energías renovables, proporcionar un transporte público mejor y ecológico, y gestionar de manera sostenible sus recursos naturales.

- **Fortalecer la resiliencia en las ciudades para reducir el riesgo y el impacto de los desastres**

Muchas ciudades han sentido el impacto de los desastres naturales y los líderes se han comprometido a poner en práctica las medidas de mitigación y adaptación para minimizar estos impactos. Algunas de estas medidas incluyen: una mejor planificación urbana, infraestructura de calidad y la mejora de las respuestas a nivel local.

- **Tomar medidas para hacer frente al cambio climático mediante la reducción de sus emisiones de gases de efecto invernadero**

Los líderes se han comprometido a involucrar no sólo al gobierno local, sino a todos los agentes de la sociedad en la acción climática teniendo en cuenta el Acuerdo de París sobre el cambio climático, que busca limitar el aumento de la temperatura mundial por debajo de los 2 grados centígrados.

- **Respetar plenamente los derechos de los refugiados, los migrantes y los desplazados internos, independientemente de su situación migratoria**

Los líderes han reconocido que la migración plantea desafíos, pero también ofrece una importante contribución a la vida urbana. Debido a esto, se han comprometido a establecer medidas que ayuden a los migrantes, los refugiados y los desplazados internos hacer contribuciones positivas a las sociedades.

- **Mejorar la conectividad y apoyar iniciativas innovadoras y ecológicas**

Esto incluye el establecimiento de asociaciones con empresas y la sociedad civil para encontrar soluciones sostenibles a los problemas urbanos.

- **Promover espacios públicos seguros, accesibles y ecológicos**

La interacción humana debe ser facilitada por la planificación urbana, por lo que en la Agenda se pide un aumento de los espacios públicos como aceras, carriles para bicicletas, jardines, plazas y parques.

## MÉXICO EN HÁBITAT III



Hábitat III es la segunda conferencia con mayor afluencia en la historia de la ONU, esta edición incluye:

- 167 países representados.
- Más de 35 mil asistentes.
- 100 mil participantes.
- 4 reuniones regionales.
- 6 reuniones temáticas.
- 3 conferencias preparatorias.

México, ha emprendido acciones para poder estructurar una Reforma Urbana integral y que incluya los conceptos recopilados en Hábitat.

En 2013 se creó la SEDATU (Secretaría de Desarrollo Agrario, Territorial y Urbano) la cual está destinada al desarrollo urbano y territorial de México.

El Poder Legislativo aprobó la Ley General de Asentamientos Humanos, Ordenamiento Territorial y Desarrollo Urbano la cual incluye nuevos principios como el Derecho a la Ciudad.

Y mejores instrumentos para:

- ▣ Planeación.
- ▣ Prevención de riesgos.
- ▣ Coordinación metropolitana.
- ▣ Ordenamiento del territorio.

## 7 EJES DE MÉXICO PARA HÁBITAT

# AGENDA

## México en Hábitat III



México aportó temas relevantes los cuales fueron abordados y discutidos en la Conferencia Hábitat III, incluyéndose los siguientes 7 ejes:

- ▣ Vivienda para construir ciudades, consiste que el sector de vivienda, en la versión ampliada del valor de su producción contribuya con el 14 % del PIB Nacional.
- ▣ Desarrollo regional para combatir la desigualdad, 8 de cada 10 mexicanos viven en zonas urbanas.
- ▣ Un nuevo marco legal para la gobernanza de las metrópolis, México cuenta con 59 zonas metropolitanas en donde habitan 60 % de la población nacional.
- ▣ Construcción de ciudades compactas y productivas, el 80.8 % de la vivienda construida por el gobierno (Sexenio del Presidente Peña Nieto período comprendido de 2012-2016) se encuentra dentro de los perímetros de contención urbana.
- ▣ Gestión eficiente del suelo con nuevas tecnologías y transparente para brindar seguridad jurídica, 70 proyectos ejecutivos de modernización que abarcan más del 81 % del territorio del país.
- ▣ Promoción de una nueva cultura del espacio público y la movilidad, del 2013 a 2016, se han realizado más de 3 mil 200 intervenciones en espacios públicos, beneficiando a más de 11 millones de personas. Plataforma Digital Ciudad Equitativa, Ciudad inclusiva, para la participación ciudadana en la planeación de la movilidad.
- ▣ Ciudades sostenibles para cuidar nuestro entorno y resilientes ante los desastres naturales, de 2013 a junio de 2016 se han construido 700, 000 viviendas que integran medidas de eficiencia energética.

## CONCLUSIÓN

Como Diputado Presidente de la Comisión de Desarrollo Urbano y Obra Pública estoy convencido que este tipo de ejercicios que vinculan a los líderes mundiales con las mentes más brillantes del mundo en temas de desarrollo de las ciudades, el crecimiento poblacional, el cuidado del medio ambiente, el urbanismo, la seguridad y todos los temas relacionados a la construcción y administración de las ciudades, hacen que los trabajos que se desarrollarán a nivel mundial cumplan el objetivo de la creación de una Nueva Agenda Urbana y que además surjan acciones y estrategias a favor del desarrollo sostenible.

Quiero desatacar que los conocimientos, el intercambio de información y las enseñanzas recibidas durante la estancia en Quito, Ecuador durante la Tercera Conferencia de las Naciones Unidas sobre la Vivienda y el Desarrollo Urbano Sostenible "Hábitat III" han sido de gran aprovechamiento personal y educativo.

Los conceptos adquiridos generarán una mejoría sustancial en el aspecto profesional de mi actuar como legislador de Guanajuato, ya que a través de este espacio de aprendizaje pude obtener nuevos conocimientos, información y documentos que compartiré con los integrantes de la Comisión que presido con la finalidad de enriquecer los trabajos legislativos que se emprenden en la comisión.

Lo importante no es solo la conferencia Hábitat III por sí sola, lo importante es lo que sucederá después de la conferencia, es decir la implementación de las acciones de los gobiernos locales y la articulación con los sectores privados y sociales para poder cumplir los objetivos incluidos en la Nueva agenda Urbana.

En lo particular, una de las cosas más significativas fue la participación activa de los jóvenes en esta Tercera conferencia, estoy seguro que entre más jóvenes se involucren en los temas de urbanismo, mejor será la proyección y desarrollo de las ciudades. Una de las cosas que emprenderemos desde la Comisión es procurar involucrar a más jóvenes para que participen activamente en los temas de la Nueva Agenda Urbana.

Desde el Congreso del Estado y particularmente desde la Comisión este encuentro internacional nos ha sido de mucho provecho para conocer las nuevas reglas y regulaciones urbanas a nivel mundial, nos ayuda para poder planificar y diseñar mejores modelos normativos en materia de Desarrollo Urbano, Obra pública y medio ambiente.

Hábitat III también ha servido para reflexionar sobre el estado de nuestras ciudades y sobre todo el derecho a una vivienda digna para todos; es decir el acceso a una vivienda adecuada que es un reto global ante el rápido crecimiento de la urbanización. Un concepto relevante surgido en esta reunión es que la vivienda de interés social deje de ser vista como un sistema financiero y que sea más una solución a la problemática social que vive el mundo actual.

Existe un número creciente de habitantes de las ciudades, especialmente los de bajos recursos, los grupos vulnerables y personas que viven en condiciones precarias, sin seguridad en la tenencia, sin acceso a los servicios básicos o el espacio vital, aislados de los medios de subsistencia y vulnerables a los desalojos forzosos o la falta de vivienda, por lo que las ciudades deben ser capaces de satisfacer estas necesidades lo cual impactará en una mejor calidad de vida y en la disminución de los problemas urbanos que hoy existen.

Las ciudades son la solución (y han sido en buena parte el problema) del cambio climático en nuestro planeta y estas son las que más sufren las consecuencias de sus efectos, por lo que es importante que en las estrategias de las ciudades sean considerados de manera primordial los sistemas de movilidad de personas, dado que los vehículos y los congestionamientos viales están generando una gran cantidad de contaminación, que son el factor primordial del cambio climático.

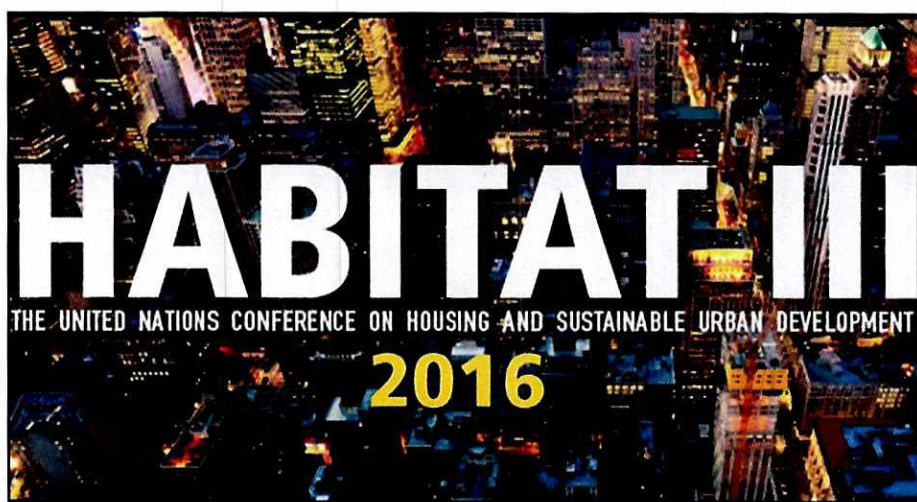
Por último es importante recordar que la Nueva Agenda Urbana no es un instrumento vinculante para los estados miembros de la ONU.

Al ser una “agenda” proporciona una orientación a los gobiernos, congresos, autoridades, sociedad civil, fundaciones, ONGs, investigadores académicos y organismos de las Naciones Unidas en sus posicionamientos con respecto a las ciudades, la urbanización y el desarrollo sustentable. Pero las orientaciones implícitas en la Agenda no son vinculantes.
